**Cost?**

- Applications received/postmarked by January 18, 2019, \$10 per solo, \$15 per ensemble.
- Applications received/postmarked by February 1, 2019, \$15 per solo, \$20 per ensemble.

**NFSF Guidelines:**

- Students must have an original copy of the music to present to the adjudicator. Students may use their own for the audition.
- Students must arrive 15 minutes prior to their scheduled performance slot
- Students who opt to perform in a solo *and* an ensemble must provide two applications, one for the solo and one for the ensemble.
- An ensemble is defined as two or more performers in a group.

**Parking:**

- You will be allowed to park in the parking garages on Saturday. *Avoid parking in the Presbyterian Church lot across the street from the College of Music.*
